



This stamp and signature is from 1882 area survey of [Dahlonega's Gold Belt](#) by Frank W. Hall; the stamp is located in the lower right-hand corner of the map. Take a moment to learn the map (click prior link) controls and make sure you scroll around the entire map. A fascinating capture of a bygone era! This Etowah Tunnel 153+/- acre Tract is located in District 12, Land Lots 178 and 142 (zoom in), where the squiggly line of the Etowah River exits the map to the south. You might compare it with the property layout at http://vinsondoverrealty.com/pdf/Etowah_tunnel_plat.pdf and recognize the U-shaped (lying on its side) bend of the River.
